



TELLER COUNTY SHOOTING SOCIETY

The Teller County Shooting Society (TCSS) was established in March of 2010. It is registered with the State of Colorado as a not-for-profit corporation and has an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) status of 501c(7): Social Club.

The TCSS is a private, not-for-profit organization with the mission of promoting the safe and responsible ownership and use of firearms. We promote the shooting sports in general as well as the ideals of self-discipline, good sportsmanship, and good citizenship within our community. We offer the residents of our community safe and secure shooting sports facilities that can be used by novice and experienced shooters alike. The TCSS is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, Membership Secretary, a Range Manager and two At-Large Directors.

The Gold Camp Shooting Sports Center (GCSSC) is a multi-venue shooting facility operated by the Teller County Shooting Society (TCSS). This facility will be operated and maintained to the highest standards of safety and environmental stewardship. The GCSSC will be safe for its users and the surrounding community. Operating hours of the GCSSC are daily from sunrise to sunset unless there is a club sponsored event scheduled, in which case, check the event details for impacts to range availability on the club website www.tcass-co.org.

Current shooting venues at the GCSSC include a 25-yard, non-covered, handgun and small caliber pistol range (currently closed for maintenance); a 100-yard covered handgun/rifle and a 400-yard rifle with berms and metal targets at 200/300/400 yards. Future projects include a shotgun skeet and trap shooting venue with a planned completion in 2022 as well as a possible extension of the 400-yard rifle range to 500-yards.

Any citizen or legal resident of the United States, 18 years of age or older, is eligible to become a member. Final membership is based upon approval by the Board of Directors (“BoD”) after the prospective new member completes a membership application, a liability waiver form, renders dues payment and participates in an on-site formal range safety orientation. New members can join, pay and complete their liability waiver via the TCSS website.

New member applicant dues received between January 1 and July 31 are \$150 with the membership valid through the end of February of the following year. New applicant dues received from August 1 through December 31 are \$75 and the membership is also through the end of February the following year. The membership year for all members runs from March 1 through the end of February the following year.

Existing member renewal dues shall be paid in full prior to March 1st. Members failing to pay renewal dues will be suspended from range use, and, if still delinquent 30 days thereafter, will be dropped from membership. Reinstatement as a Member will require reapplication and payment at the full membership fee of \$150.

Public Days for non-members are hosted on weekends from mid-April into November to help increase our membership numbers and provide support for the grants we receive from CPW. Member Only Days are held once a month on Saturdays beginning in April, continuing into November. Included are a variety of shooting contests as well as a club hosted BBQ lunch.
